



The North Carolina Ranch Horse Show Series

- The NCRH classes will be judged with ARHA rules in all circumstances *EXCEPT*
 - The NCRH classes will allow LTD riders to ride a horse of any age two handed in a snaffle or a rawhide bosal (as permitted for junior horses) should they chose to do so. Otherwise, an exhibitor may ride one handed on any curb bit.
- A LTD rider may NOT compete in any cattle classes at all. LTD classes are designed for riders who are green and are less confident at the lope. Because cattle classes can involve full control of a horse at any/all gaits, it is deemed unsafe for a LTD rider to compete in cattle classes.
- ARHA/NCRH classes run concurrently will be placed separately.
- Riders who are registered to compete ARHA/NCRH will only ride once per class. One run will be placed accordingly to each division.
- A competitor who is not a member of NCRH will *not* be eligible for any awards—day, season, or otherwise.
- Competitors of classes will be judged through 10th place but will only be awarded ribbons through 6th place.
- We aim to provide a friendly atmosphere. Please be kind and courteous to your animals, other competitors, and the facility.
